Aphrodite Condrieu, Domaine Denuzière 2011

Rhône Valley, France

Condrieu is where the finest Viogniers are produced. The appellation was created in 1940, and today over 40 growers make wines from just over 100 hectares of vineyards. The wines are dry with a wonderful floral nose of peaches, apricots, violets and pear.

Meursault 1er Cru Les Charmes, Domaine Mazilly 2015

Burgundy, France

There are more top producers here than in any other commune of the Côte d'Or, and its wines are typically rich and savoury with nutty, honeyed hints and buttery, vanilla spice from the oak. Even though considerably larger than its southerly neighbours Chassagne and Puligny, Meursault contains no Grands Crus. Winner of numerous medals in prestigious competitions, Domaine Mazilly has been among established Burgundian wine estate for several years. This Chardonnay has got aromas of toasted hazelnuts, butter, honey and stone fruits.

STEPHEN'S PERSONAL COLLECTION

These wines are Grand Cru Classé from Bordeaux. They were selected by Stephen 10 years ago and are now perfect to enjoy.

Château Giscours Margaux 3ème Cru Classé 2006 **£195**
Margaux, France

Chateau Giscours is one of the largest properties in the Medoc, the property was taken over Dutch businessman Eric Albada-Jelgersma in 1995. Herbaceous, earthy, truffle notes intermixed with sweet cherries, plum, and currant are present in this soft, medium wine.

Château Leoville Barton 2ème Cru Classé 2008 **£220**
Saint Julien, France

Leoville Barton is now one of two Chateau from the 1855 Classification of the Medoc that remains in the hands of the same family that owned it at the time it was classified. Tobacco leaf, cigar wrapper, cedar and green pepper corns are the first you notice. Full bodied, quite crisp and sharp, this is concentrated, peppery and crisp.

Château Figeac 1er Cru Classé 2004 **£295**
Saint Emilion, France

Chateau Figeac is an ancient Bordeaux vineyard. In fact, the genesis of the estate can be dated as far back as the second century during the ancient Gallo-Roman period. At that time, the owner of the property, Figeacus gave his name to the villa he built on the same location. Dry and complex with ripe red fruits and berries, dried figs, toast with long finish.

Château Talbot 4ème Cru Classé 2009 **£320**
Saint Julien, France

This Saint-Julien estate benefits from vines aged 57 years on average, planted on gravel typical of the Medoc. Voluminous, with soft, ripe berry fruit flavours spreading easily across the cushioned palate.

Château Pichon-Longueville 2ème Grand Cru Classé 2006 **£395**
Pauillac, France

The 75 hectares of this vineyard border the property of Chateau Latour and stretch south of Pauillac towards the commune of Saint Julien, it gets its extraordinary charm. Exudes a mix of raspberry, violet, cherry juice expressions, along with cigar notes.
